

Technical Review of Submissions

The Urban Confluence Silicon Valley Ideas Competition submission **deadline is July 1, 2020**. As a courtesy we are offering a Technical Review for the following items on all submissions received prior to Monday, June 22, 2020 at 11:00 PM PDT. If any errors are discovered by our Technical Review Team, you will be notified. It will be your responsibility to make the appropriate edits to your submission on Submittable prior to the July 1 submission deadline. Thank you!

Submissions must include the following:

1. English language only
2. One Design Presentation Board PDF consisting of 2 boards (layout can be 2 horizontal, 2 vertical, or 1 horizontal and 1 vertical) precisely labelled "DesignPresentationBoard.pdf"
3. A 2-inch empty square in the upper right-hand corners of the 2 boards
4. The required Site Map Image (in any size) on the Design Presentation Board PDF must be included on 1 of the 2 boards
5. Project Statement precisely labelled "ProjectStatement.doc" (Word file)
6. Project Summary precisely labelled "ProjectSummary.doc" (Word file)
7. Precise File Names used on all Phase 1 Revised Submission Requirements (e.g. "ProjectStatement.doc", NOT "project_statement.DOC")
8. All measurements in the Imperial System (not the Metric System)
9. Submitters' Net-Zero strategy. You must "Invoke net-zero energy design principles in the design of the site" (see page 10 of the Competition Brief). You can include net-zero comments in your Project Statement and/or include net-zero elements on your Design Presentation Board in order to satisfy the competition's net-zero requirement. You are allowed to include as much or as little information related to net-zero as you choose, as long as you address the net-zero requirement.

Submissions must also follow the guidelines listed below:

1. One submission per email address
2. Use 14-point type or larger on your Design Presentation Board.
3. Submitter anonymity is required in the following sections of your Submission: Project Title, Design Presentation Board, Project Statement, Project Summary, Optional Video Rendering, and Site Map Image (These sections must NOT include any identification marks such as personal, company, or institutional names, logos, websites, links, or email address that would violate the anonymity of the submitters)
4. Optional Video Rendering must NOT contain any links or other information that violates the competition's anonymity requirements
5. Designed areas must be limited to "West Side Area Available for Design Competition" and "East Side Area Available for Design Competition" (see Site Map Image)
6. Designed areas must respect the 100-foot Riparian Setbacks
7. Design must respect the 200-foot Height Limit
8. No graphic images are allowed to be included on Project Statements and Project Summaries
9. The maximum file size for the Design Presentation Board, Project Statement, Project Summary, and Optional Video Rendering is 400MB
10. Read the Required Resources for Submitters including:
 - Lighting Report - Arena Green
 - Lighting Guidelines
 - Biology Report - Arena Green
 - Aviation Considerations
